ITINERARY

FRIDAY, APR 28 - UNITED STATES TO DUBLIN

Depart Dulles on United flight 126 at 10:25 pm for Dublin. Enjoy in-flight entertainment and meal service as you travel to start your vacation.

SATURDAY, APR 29 - DUBLIN ARRIVAL & GALWAY

After landing at Dublin Airport, complete customs and immigration formalities. Your Caddie Tours driver/guide will welcome you to Ireland and escort you and your luggage to the coach. Next, stop for breakfast at the Coachman's Inn with your group. Depart Dublin and journey across the rolling pastures of Ireland's heartland and stop outside Kilbeggan to visit the Kilbeggan Distillery, which was established in 1757 and is one of the oldest licensed distillery in the world. After your visit, travel to Galway and check into your hotel. The balance of the afternoon is free for individual pursuits. In the evening join your fellow travelers for dinner in the hotel restaurant.

DINNER & OVERNIGHT: RADISSON BLU HOTEL, GALWAY (B,D)

SUNDAY, APR 30 - GALWAY WALK & KYLEMORE ABBEY

Today join a local guide for a gentle walking tour. See the medieval city walls, Lynch's Castle and the narrow streets. Next tour Connemara and admire the sweeping views of boglands and misty mountains. As you drive along you will see many sheep that graze freely and also tracts of bogland where some people hand-cut peat for home heating. Then visit Kylemore Abbey for a tour of the elegant mansion and church, set beside a tranquil lake. Also walk through the magical Victorian walled garden. Return to Galway and enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure.

MONDAY, MAY 1 - CLIFFS OF MOHER & KILLARNEY

Drive around Galway Bay and through the Burren, a unique region of limestone hills renowned for its flora and prehistoric stone monuments. Stop to view the majestic Cliffs of Moher, a rocky wall that rises nearly 700 feet above the foaming Atlantic Ocean. Take a short ferry ride across the River Shannon Estuary to the mountainous countryside of Kerry. Arrive in Killarney and check into your hotel. Then you will have the afternoon free to relax or stroll around town before dinner.

DINNER & OVERNIGHT: MALTON HOTEL, KILLARNEY (B,D)

TUESDAY, MAY 2 - RING OF KERRY TOUR

Today explore the Ring of Kerry - 100 miles of marvelous scenery consisting of the highest peaks in Ireland on one side and a coast-line scattered with golden beaches and rocky headlands on the other. Enjoy plenty of stops to view the scenery and take phot os. Travel through Glenbeigh, Cahirciveen and on to Waterville and the colorful village of Sneem. Stop at Lady's View for a view of the three Lakes of Killarney before returning to Killarney for a free evening.

OVERNIGHT: MALTON HOTEL, KILLARNEY (B)

WEDNESDAY, MAY 3 - BLARNEY CASTLE & WATERFORD

Leaving Killarney, drive to Blarney, where you can climb the battlements of Blarney Castle and kiss the famous "Stone of Eloquence." Also visit the Blarney Woollen Mills, which has an excellent range of Irish products of all types. They will ship and insure goods for you. Then drive to the east of Cork city visit the Old Midleton Distillery. Learn how the distillery makes whiskey as you walk through the old buildings. At the end of your tour, enjoy a sampling of the finished product. Then motor along the south coast of Ireland via Youghal and Dungarvan to Waterford. Upon arrival check into your hotel and enjoy some time to settle in before dinner with your group. After dinner, take a short walking tour through the older sections of Waterford with a local guide. DINNER & OVERNIGHT: FAITHLEGG HOUSE HOTEL, WATERFORD (B,D)




THURSDAY, MAY 4 - WATERFORD CRYSTAL & GLENDALOUGH

Today visit the House of Waterford Crystal to learn about glass blowing, cutting and see one-of-a-kind masterpieces. From Waterford, travel through Avoca and its picturesque Vale of Avoca to Glendalough. Visit the 6th century monastic settlement with the ruins of seven churches and a round tower. Then drive to Dublin, where you will check into your hotel for dinner and your overnight stay. DINNER & OVERNIGHT: CAMDEN COURT HOTEL, DUBLIN (B,D)

FRIDAY. MAY 5- DUBLIN HIGHLIGHTS

Set off with a local guide who will show you around Dublin. Stop in Trinity College to view the 8th century Book of Kells, an illuminated manuscript of the gospels. Next visit the Guinness Storehouse to see exhibits on how this world famous stout was first created and why it is so popular today. Finish your visit in the roof-top bar, where you can sample a draft Guinness. The balance of the day is free for independent activities, sightseeing, shopping and much more. **OVERNIGHT: CAMDEN COURT HOTEL, DUBLIN (B)**





SATURDAY, MAY 6 - RETURN TO THE UNITED STATES

Transfer to Dublin Airport in plenty of time to check in United flight 127 departing at 12:25 pm for Washington. You may do some last minute shopping at the duty free stores before boarding your aircraft and flying across the Atlantic Ocean back to the United States.
